RULES AND REGULATIONS

TUESDAY HORSESHOE LEAGUE

ALL GAMES ARE PLAYED FOR A DRINK. IF THE DRINK IS MORE THAN \$2.50, THE WINNER PAYS THE DIFFERENCE. THERE WILL BE NO EXCHANGING OF MONEY OR DRINK CHIPS.

EACH SPONSOR MUST PROVIDE A SCOREBOARD, ADEQUATE LIGHTING AND WELL MAINTAINED PITS WITH A RAKE AND A BROOM.

IF YOUR REGULAR PLAYER ISN'T THERE TO PLAY HIS FIRST GAME, YOU MAY BRING IN A SUB TO PLAY HIS FIRST GAME. IF HE IS THERE TO PLAY HIS SECOND GAME THEN HE MAY PLAY THE REMAINING GAMES. IF HE ISN'T THERE FOR THE SECOND GAME THE SUB MUST FINISH THE NIGHT, EVEN IF THE REGULAR PLAYER SHOWS UP FOR THE THIRD GAME.

IF A SITUATION OCCURS WHEREIN A PLAYER IS NOT ABLE TO CONTINUE TO SHOOT, A SUBSTITUTE MAY BE BROUGHT IN WITH BOTH CAPTAIN'S APPROVAL. IF CAPTAINS ARE IN DISAGREEMENT, THEN THE LEAGUE PRESIDENT WILL BE CALLED AND WILL MAKE THE FINAL DECISION.

MAKE UP GAMES MUST BE MADE UP WITHIN 10 DAYS.

RAIN GAMES WILL BE MADE UP AT THE END OF THE SEASON UNLESS OTHER ARRANGEMENTS ARE MADE BY THE OPPOSING TEAMS.

PLAYER'S FEES ARE \$5.00 PER WEEK. SPONSOR FEE IS \$40.00 PER TEAM.

STARTING TIME IS 7:00 PM.

DROP OFF POINT FOR PLAYERS' FEES AND SCORESHEETS IS HUSHER BY MIDNIGHT THE NIGHT OF PLAY.

ALL PLAYERS MUST BE A MINIMUM OF 21 YEARS OLD.

PITCHING DISTANCE FOR WOMEN, SENIOR MEN AND HANDICAPPED PERSONS SHALL BE A MINIMUM 30 FEET WITH A FOUL LINE 27 FEET FROM THE STAKE. FOUL LINES SHALL BE MARKED 10 FEET IN FRONT OF THE 40 FOOT FOUL LINE.

PARTNERS ARE TO BE CONSISTENT THROUGHOUT THE SEASON IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR TOP PARTNER PRIZES(1ST, 2ND & 3RD)

BANQUET TO BE HELD AT TAVERN OF FIRST PLACE WINNER. IF FIRST PLACE TEAM DOES NOT HAVE 4 PITS WITH LIGHTING THEN TAVERN NAMES THAT QUALIFY ARE PLACED IN A HAT AND WINNING TAVERN DRAWN WILL HOST THE BANQUET
